

Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting

23 May 2007

Members present: R. Stephen Leighton, Chairman, JoAnn Brown and Lynn Sweet.

Meeting was called to order at 8:00 A.M.

A letter was signed for Mr. and Mrs. Reynolds, as requested by them, advising that the road they live on is a Class VI road. Although the public has the right to use it, the Town does not maintain it and cannot legally expend taxpayer's money to maintain or repair it.

There was a discussion regarding Webber Road and the legal requirements/findings necessary in order to declare an emergency lane. "The public need for keeping such lane passable by emergency vehicles is supported by an identified public welfare or safety interest which surpasses or differs from any private benefits to landowners abutting such lane" RSA 231:59-a, II. The Board will be meeting with the residents on June 5th. At that time, the landowners will be given an opportunity to provide information to prove that this action would meet the above criteria and serve the "public need", not just the landowners on the road.

Mr. Leighton contacted BG Environmental in Barrington to request a proposal for removal of waste from cleaning uniforms and gear. A proposal will be forthcoming.

There being no further business before the Board, a motion was made, seconded and voted to adjourn. The meeting adjourned at 8:30 A.M.
