### Public Hearing

The public hearing was called to order at 6:00 P.M..

Dave Copeland presented copies and explained the intent of the proposed changes.

A question was raised pertaining to sprinklers, however, although there had been discussion in the past, any changes pertaining to that or any other building regulation would have to be approved at Town Meeting.
