

## Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting August 11, 2009

The meeting was called to order at 6 P.M.

The Selectmen reviewed the bills and checks for payment.

There was additional discussion about adding the Clerk's software to Tax Collector's existing work station and the purchase of a new printer. The Board was advised that the State of NH will not be funding the printer as anticipated, but there is enough of a balance remaining in the Town Clerks budget to fund the purchase. The Board agreed that as long as there are enough funds within the Town Clerk's budget it was okay to go forward with the purchases.

Update on Bow Lake Road bridge-

The Board discussed the costs for the 20' bridge. It was agreed to move forward with the recommendations as proposed by Dubois and King.
