

Minutes of the Selectmen's Meeting 12 November 2013

In attendance: Ken Berry

The meeting was called to order at 6:01PM.

Payroll and bills were reviewed and payment was approved. Correspondence was reviewed and discussed as necessary.

Minutes from the October 29, 2013 Selectmen's Meeting were read and approved.

The Board signed the State equalization survey submitted by the assessor.

The Selectmen noted that there is no need for a public hearing to establish the speed limit on the section of Province Road from Ricky Nelson Road to Route 202A. That had been established in the recent ordinance update in anticipation of the Town taking ownership of that section of road. The Selectmen's Office will ask Greg Messenger to put up the 30mph signs.

Ken Berry requested and was given a copy of the Town Ordinances.

The Selectmen approved a request to pay for certification classes for the Deputy Tax Collector.

The Town received a certificate from the NH Register of Big Trees for an 80 foot white ash located on the Isinglass River Conservation Reserve. It will be forwarded to the Conservation Commission.

A correction was noted in the cost of health insurance for 2014. It will be an 11.5% increase, rather than 11%.

The Board discussed several aspects of the plan to hire a part-time bookkeeper, including qualifications, the interview process, training, and creating a workspace for him/her. The Selectmen's Office will proceed by posting the advertisement in the Foster's Daily Democrat, on the Town's website, and in several locations around Town. Applications will be due on November 25th.

There being no further business to be brought before the Board a motion was made, seconded, and voted to adjourn. The meeting adjourned at 7:10PM.
