

Minutes of the Selectmen's Meeting 28 May 2013

Members present: JoAnn Brown, Chairman, Jim Andersen

The meeting was called to order at 6:15PM.

Minutes were read and approved as written. Payroll and bills were reviewed and payment approved. Correspondence was reviewed and discussed as necessary.

Fire Chief Scott Whitehouse will be attending the June 11th Board meeting.

The Selectmen discussed 2 matters pertaining to Primex, one being a refund due and the other a current workman's compensation case.

The Selectmen briefly discussed the State's work on Province Road and decided not to have the road striped as that portion of the road will become a Town road when the State's work is complete. The Selectmen will request that the State removes a dead maple tree along Province Road before they accept maintenance of the road.

Some discussion followed about the summer beach operations. Signs will be posted in the port -a-potty units to remind users that the beach area is a carry in/carry out area; some problems arose last year with the units being used for trash disposal.

It was the consensus of the Board to continue testing the wells currently being tested with regard to the Strafford Landfill.

The job of boarding up first floor access to a Town owned building/property on Second Crown Pont Road has been completed. The Selectmen will continue to monitor the site for safety issues and illegal dumping.

There being no further business to be brought before the Board a motion was made, seconded, and voted to adjourn. The meeting adjourned at 6:35PM.
