

## Minutes of the Selectmen's Meeting December 29, 2020

The business portion of the Selectmen's Meeting was called to order at 5:30PM. Payroll and bills were reviewed and approved for payment. Minutes from the December 15th Selectmen's Meeting were read and approved with amendment.

### **Old Business**

Department heads have submitted their budgets. The Selectmen will hold a work session on January 5<sup>th</sup> for an initial review of departmental budgets and the complete Town budget. They will meet with department heads at subsequent meetings to review their budgets and review warrant article requests.

At this time a motion was made by Scott Young and seconded by Brian Monahan to enter into a non-public session pursuant to RSA 91-A:3 II (e). Roll call was taken as follows:

Current operations at the Recycling Center were discussed. Mr. Young will follow up their conversation with the attendants there. They also discussed the expanded use, and therefore

increased cost, of the demolition container at the Recycling Center. The Selectmen's Office will investigate how other towns handle the situation, and will likely make some changes about the use of the containers or fees for the use.
