

Minutes of the Selectmen's Meeting

July 28, 2020

The business portion of the Selectmen's Meeting was called to order at 5:25PM.

Payroll and bills were reviewed and approved for payment. A Yield Tax Warrant and an Intent to Cut Timber were signed. The Selectmen reviewed and adopted the proposed yield tax rates for the 2020-2021 Timber Year. Board member reviewed wetlands permitting for a property on Jodi Lane

Appointments

6:00 – Jeffrey Sanita, Parker Mountain Road, attended the Selectmen's Meeting to discuss serving on the Zoning Board of Adjustment as an alternate member. Mr. Sanita told Board members a bit about himself as he is new to the area. He has attended some public meetings this year. Board members explained some particulars about the Board of Adjustment and stressed the need to be familiar with the RSAs and to remain objective as appeals are presented. As an alternate, he will have great opportunities to listen and learn as he attends meetings.

Old Business

The Selectmen reviewed current "reopening plan" and discussed necessity of any changes. The operations at the Town Hall are running very smoothly. Residents and Town Hall staff have been voluntarily practicing social distancing of and respectful of one another's sensibilities concerning the virus. Two changes were suggested. With a decrease in traffic to the Tax Collector's Office, it was suggested that Ms. Dupré begin to use her inside window for business in that office. As of August 3rd, 4 people will be permitted in the lobby. That situation will be reviewed on an ongoing basis.

Pending legal matters were briefly reviewed. With Covid related closures and postponements, court extensions into 2021 have been granted.

New Business

The lifeguards will be on duty at the lake through August 15th. The portable toilets will remain in the parking lot through mid-September.

The auditors are scheduled to be in the office August 4th and 5th for the onsite portion of their work.

There are 2 job openings at the Town Office. The Selectmen are hoping to fill the positions for a Deputy Town Clerk and a Land Use Secretary.

There being no further business to address, a motion was made and seconded to adjourn. The meeting was adjourned at 6:20PM.
