

Minutes of the Selectmen's Meeting November 20, 2018

Members Present: Lynn Sweet, Chairman, Bryant Scott and Scott Young
In attendance: Judy Dupré, Alan Williams

The Selectmen's Meeting was called to order at 5:30PM.

The Selectmen reviewed and approved payment of payroll and bills. A yield tax warrant and abatement recommendation were reviewed and signed.

The status of the new electrical shed at the Recycling Center was discussed. The project is waiting for the electrician to transfer the electrical equipment into the new shed. The necessity of some outside lighting and interior lighting on the shed were suggested. The Board will ask the electrician to address that as well as making a suggestion for how best to darken the Recycling Center area during the nighttime hours when closed.

Judy Dupré reviewed the status of 2016 lien payments with the Board members and discussed some properties that are in danger of tax deeding. Ms. Dupré also presented a request to the Board for forgiveness of the interest on a late payment of the 2018 first issue tax bill. The Board members denied the request.

At this time a motion was made by Lynn Sweet and seconded by Scott Young to enter into a non-public session pursuant to RSA 91-A:3 II (a) and (e). Roll call was taken as follows:

The Board entered non-public session at 6:05PM.

Selectmen Scott arrived at the meeting at approximately 6:12PM.

A motion was made by Lynn Sweet to leave non-public session and seconded by Bryant Scott to return to public session. Roll call was taken as follows:

Public session reconvened at 6:47PM.

No votes were taken during the non-public session.

A motion was made by Scott Young and seconded by Lynn Sweet to seal the minutes of the non-public session. Roll call was taken as follows:

The Selectmen discussed a UPS request for permission to routinely park a trailer in the Town Hall parking lot. The request was denied.

The completion of court ordered cleanup on a property on Parker Mountain Road was discussed. A few additional items have yet to be moved and/or cleaned up to comply with the agreement that was made.

Department heads will submit their preliminary budgets before the next meeting along with additional requests not included in regular budgets.

Ed Merrill, General Manager of Atlantic Broadband(formerly Metrocast) has contacted the Selectmen's Office with an update concerning service to the Parson's Hill/Evans Mountain Road area. Included was a list of the homes being offered internet service internet from Atlantic Broadband. The Selectmen will review the list, checking to see if service is available to all residents in the area. Discussion will continue at future meetings.

There being no further business to bring before the Board, it was moved by Mr. Young and seconded by Mr. Scott to adjourn the meeting. By unanimous vote, the meeting adjourned at 7:10PM.
