

## Minutes of the Selectmen's Meeting August 14, 2018

In attendance: Greg Messenger, Matthew Messenger, Judy Dupré, Fire Chief Scott Whitehouse

The Selectmen's Meeting was called to order at 5:25PM.

Bills and payroll were reviewed and approved. Minutes of the August 7th meeting were read and amended. The Selectmen reviewed correspondence and briefly discussed its contents.

With those in attendance several roadway issues were discussed. "Dillon Drive East" has 2 new homes on it which are separated from other homes on the by an impassable section of road. It was suggested that the roadway with the new homes, be given a different name. This would facilitate emergency personnel responses and generally make it easier for anyone locating the properties. Several names were suggested, but no decision was made. The Selectmen authorized the renaming of the section of Whig Hill Road which encompasses the house lots numbered in the 1300s. It's inaccessibility to the other portion of Whig Hill Road has caused confusion and delay in emergency response time. It will be renamed Old Whig Hill Road. Greg Messenger will order a sign. 911 Coordinator, Judy Dupré, reported that newly named Red Oak Lane, off Drake Hill Road has all the releases necessary. The name will be effective as of October 1<sup>st</sup>, giving Greg time to order a sign. Finally, the Board discussed the necessity of a drainage easement on Map 33 Lot 75 at the intersection of Dillon Drive and Browns Pasture. The Selectmen's Office will provide the easement for the property owner to sign.

Progress on the new electrical building was discussed. A pad for the building has been made and concrete will be poured. The building is on order and an electrician has been secured.

Scott Whitehouse and the Board member discussed the status of the proposed Crown Point Fire station. It appears that there is not enough land to build the station as planned. He and the Board discussed seeking a lot line adjustment with an abutting land owner.

There being no further business it was moved and seconded to adjourn the meeting. The meeting was adjourned at 6:40PM
