

## Minutes of the Selectmen's Work Session March 19, 2019

Members Present: Lynn Sweet, Chairman, Bryant Scott, and Scott Young  
In attendance: 911 Coordinator Judith Dupré

The Selectmen's Work Session was called to order at 5:35PM.

The first order of business was the election of the Chairman of the Selectboard for the upcoming year. Bryant Scott motioned to nominate Lynn Sweet for the position. It was seconded by Scott Young. A vote was taken as follows:

Lynn Sweet – Aye, Bryant Scott – Aye, Scott Young – Aye

The Selectmen signed pay rate slips reflecting increases approved at Town Meeting. Contracts were reviewed and signed along with accompanying pay rate notices.

Data Collectors from KRT, the Town's contract assessors, will in Town over the next month or so reviewing property improvements as a result of 2018 building permits. They will also be reviewing 2017 and 2018 sale properties as well as the cyclical review of the data from numerous properties in Town. Information will be posted on the town website when more information is available. The Selectmen have requested to meet with representatives from KRT on April 9<sup>th</sup> at 6:00.

911 Coordinator Judith Dupré and the Selectmen discussed the naming of a new "driveway" off Drake Hill Road. A 3 lot subdivision (M4 Lots 31, 31-1, and 31-2) with a shared driveway has been approved; that will necessitate the naming of the driveway. Maple Lane was suggested and by unanimous decision it was accepted. Ms. Dupré will make the appropriate notifications. A public hearing to discuss the renaming of a portion of Whig Hill Road, often referred to as Old Whig Hill Road, will be held on March 26, 2019 at 6:00PM.

With all Board members present, the Selectmen, after consideration of several names for the renaming of the newly developed portion of Dillon Drive East, chose a new name for the roadway. A motion was made by Ms. Sweet to name the roadway Thorne Lane. It was seconded by Mr. Young. A vote was taken as follows:

Lynn Sweet – Aye, Bryant Scott – Aye, Scott Young – Aye

The Selectmen discussed a request from a resident for the public posting of a Police Log. Board members were in complete agreement that this is a decision to be made by Police Chief Mike Richard. They will share the request with him.

The Selectmen signed a contract with Dubois & King for the scope and fees portion of the engineering for the Barn Door gap bridge.

Several electrical issues are being addressed at the Recycling Center. A pole was accidentally snapped off during routine trash pickup. The new pole has been set, and electricity reconnected in the next day or two. A work order is in place with Eversource for some necessary work on the lines and/or transformer. The Selectmen are working with a new electrician for the completion of the new shed to replace the cinder block building.

A request was made at the close of Town Meeting to combine the School District at Town Meetings on the same day. The logistics and feasibility of that were discussed.

There being no further business to discuss, it was moved and seconded to adjourn the work session. The work session adjourned at 7:10AM.
