

Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting

19 February 2008

Members present: R. Stephen Leighton, Chairman, JoAnn Brown and Lynn Sweet.

Meeting was called to order at 6:00 P.M.

Letter received by Tax Collector requesting that property owner be exempted from payment of the interest due on delinquent tax bill was discussed. Concern was voiced over setting a precedent. Motion was made, seconded and voted to deny this request.

There was discussion regarding the dedication to Ted Huckins to be included in the 2007 Year Ending Town Report. All were in agreement that a picture should be included, if possible.

It was noted that detailed information will be included for the Police Department as requested previously.

There was a brief discussion regarding Article 9 and 10 and the revolving fund for ambulance services. It was noted that the Board has not specified a position or wages, etc., although some municipalities do this and do not have to come back to the Town for a vote. The Board's intention is to include warrant articles in the future (for a specific purposes i.e. wages, position, etc.) and to request a withdrawal from the revolving fund to help fund the article.

There was a short discussion regarding the fees that were charged for building permits on large barns and/or commercial buildings. Commercial rates do apply if the building has the potential to be used for commercial purposes. Board will discuss revision of building permit fees in the near future.

There being no further business before the Board, a motion was made, seconded and voted to adjourn. The meeting adjourned at 6:30 P.M.
