

Minutes of Selectmen's Work Session

5 June 2008

Members present: R. Stephen Leighton, Chairman, Lynn Sweet and Stephanie Gray.

Work was called to order at 8:00 A.M.

Scott Young (Police Chief) attended.

At this time a motion was made by Mr. Leighton to enter into nonpublic session pursuant to RSA 91-A:3, II (a) to discuss personnel issues. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Sweet. Roll call vote as taken as follows: Mr. Leighton – Aye, Mrs. Sweet – Aye, and Mrs. Gray – Aye. The Board entered into nonpublic session at 8:05 A.M. At this time a motion was made by Mr. Leighton to come out of nonpublic session and seconded by Mrs. Sweet. Roll call vote was taken as follows: Mr. Leighton – Aye, Mrs. Sweet – Aye, and Mrs. Gray – Aye. The Board came out of nonpublic session at 8:35 A.M. No votes were taken.

Mr. Leighton made a motion not to release the minutes of the nonpublic session. His motion was seconded by Mrs. Sweet. Roll call vote was taken as follows: Mr. Leighton – Aye, Mrs. Sweet – Aye, and Mrs. Gray – Aye.

Chief Young discussed the two grants that have been applied for and awarded (DUI and OHRV). A motion was made, seconded and voted by the Board to authorize the Police Department to accept the funding and to conduct these details for 2008/2009. Mr. Leighton, Chairman, was authorized to sign and enter into any agreement associated with the details and/or funding.

There was discussion regarding the use of the patrol cars and the K-9. It was noted that vehicles must be available to officers for patrols associated with grant funded details. After discussing the amount of equipment to be moved when K-9 is used (primarily on weekends), the Police Chief requested permission to use (lease for \$1.) officer's own vehicle as the K-9 vehicle. Chief has verified with Town Attorney and Insurance, and no problems were foreseen. Costs associated with the K-9 will continue to be paid for by donations. Decals for vehicle were paid for by the officer and officer is under agreement that this vehicle is not available for private use during this time. Board suggested Chief include an article in the Town Calendar and provide information to Foster's, in an effort to keep the public informed.

A motion was made, seconded and voted to adjourn. Work session adjourned at 9:00 A.M.
