Mike Burns presented his plan to construct a "Good as New Shed" for the Recycling Center. This is a project he hopes to complete as part of his requirements to attain the rank of Eagle Scout. Materials that might be used for the construction and size of building were discussed. Mr. Kitz attended to support the project. Possibility of lighting was mentioned. Types of items to be accepted and what would not be accepted, along with suggestions for operation and maintenance of the building, were discussed. Board recommended a 10' X 14' due to limited space. A motion was made, seconded and voted to give the project conditional approval. Mr. Burns will return with tentative design for the building after the project is approved by the Eagle Board.

Information compiled for Town Meeting was reviewed. A work session was set for Sunday, March 8th at 11:30 A.M. Board will go over the presentation and information available pertaining to the "Pay as you Throw" question on the warrant for Town Meeting.

There was a discussion pertaining to the recent ice storm and the volume of paperwork, data required, time constraints attached, and responsibility involved when making application to FEMA for a partial reimbursement.

The Board mentioned the first Saturday in May as a tentative date to schedule the ribbon cutting at the new Town Hall building.

After discussion, Board was in agreement to send a letter to the Energy Committee to thank them for all they have done. Although they have no authority or jurisdiction, the Board appreciates their time and effort.

Upcoming appointments were discussed. After discussion a motion was made, seconded and voted to make the following new appointments:
