

Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting

7 August 2009

Members present: Lynn Sweet, Chairman, Stephanie Gray and R. Stephen Leighton.

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 A.M.

At this time, a motion was made by Ms. Sweet and seconded by Mr. Leighton to enter into non-public session pursuant to RSA 91-A:3, II (e). A roll call vote was taken as follows; Mrs. Sweet – Aye, Ms. Gray- Aye and Mr. Leighton- Aye. The Board entered into non-public session at 7:01 A.M.

At this time, a motion was made by Ms. Sweet and seconded by Mr. Leighton to come out of non-public session. A roll call vote was taken as follows; Mrs. Sweet- Aye, Ms. Gray- Aye and Mr. Leighton – Aye. The Board came out of non-public session at 7:25 A.M. No vote was taken.

A motion was made by Ms. Sweet and seconded by Mr. Leighton to seal the minutes of the non-public session. A roll call vote was taken as follows; Ms. Sweet – Aye, Ms. Gray – Aye and Mr. Leighton – Aye.

It was noted that a representative from PSNH will inspect the new Town Hall on Monday at 1:00 P.M. At that time, paperwork will be submitted to proceed with request for rebate associated with construction of the new building.

Progress on application for Water Street dock replacement was discussed.

After short discussion, Board was in agreement that a notice pertaining to a political fundraising function could not be posted at the town hall.

There was discussion pertaining to a citizen's concern over the location the of where the pavement ends on 1st Crown Point Road and other new roads recently paved within the Town. It was noted that the Developers, not the Town, were responsible for the paving.

Stickers for the Recycling Center were discussed. The need to set up a day/time for those without to get them, and to remind people that they are required to be displayed, was noted.

Correspondence was read.

Board will discuss BLOCA and Garden Club's request to plant a memorial tree on the Town Hall property, at their next meeting.
