

Minutes of the Selectmen's Meeting April 12, 2016

Selectmen in attendance: Bryant Scott and Scott Young
In attendance: Greg Messenger, Eric Rowe

The Selectmen's Meeting commenced at 5:28.

The Board reviewed and approved payroll and payment of bills. Minutes from the April 5, 2016 Selectmen's Work Session were read and approved. Appointment slips were signed for police officers, Evan Ortega and Greg Iannacci.

The Selectmen reviewed with Greg paving estimates for the work slated to be done in Town this summer. Greg will continue to work with Pike Industries, as in previous years, for the paving of Leonard Caverly Road, Spencer Lane, a portion of Province Road (where some culvert work has already been done) and perhaps a portion of Tasker Hill Road.

Several technology matters regarding the new server were discussed. With some minor electrical accommodations, it will be possible to house the server in the utility room off the conference room rather than in the Selectmen's Office. Three of the office's laptops are not able to be connected to the server due to age and software incompatibility. Upgrades may be purchased, but, because of the age of the computers, it has been recommended that they be replaced. The Selectmen approved both the recommendation to replace the laptops and the electrical accommodations for moving the server. EMF will check into pricing on the laptops. Remote access by KRT to the assessing computer is still being investigated.

Eric Rowe, Evans Mountain Road, talked with the Selectmen about several matters. He had previously made copies of grant materials available to the Conservation Commission and the Selectmen. Realizing that timing is tight for the submission year's grant application, Mr. Rowe acknowledged that it might have to be postponed until the next grant cycle. Mr. Rowe also discussed Evans Mountain Road with regard to Class VI, discontinued or abandoned status. Mr. Rowe would like to see this determination settled so that all involved can move forward together. Mr. Rowe also requested information about the Town's OHRV policy. The discussion ended with a brief discussion about the duties of the Conservation Commission.

The Selectmen requested recent minutes from the Conservation Commission meetings and read through the State Statutes pertaining to the Conservation Commission for a better understanding of their purpose and authority.

There being no further business to be brought before the Board a motion was made, seconded, and voted to adjourn. The meeting adjourned at 6:45PM.
