

Minutes of the Selectmen's Meeting August 18, 2015

Members present: Lynn Sweet and Bryant Scott

In attendance: Police Chief Scott Young

The Selectmen's meeting commenced at 6:30PM.

The Selectmen reviewed and authorized payroll and payment of bills. A Timber Intent to Cut and MS-1 Extension request were signed. Minutes of the August 4th meeting were read and approved.

The Selectmen reviewed and denied a request from David Whitcher concerning the delay of assessment adjustments for a recent unmerger which had been granted and executed. The Selectmen's Office will notify Mr. Whitcher by letter.

The Request for Proposal for the Town's assessing contract has been reviewed by NHDRA; it will be sent out in early September.

The lifeguards at Bow Lake Beach have completed their work for the 2015 season; all have expressed interest in returning in 2016.

Approval was given by Board members for a request by the Building Inspector on behalf of a resident to dig for the repair of a water line, which is an essential service, near a cemetery.

There was some discussion about additional service our payroll company may provide to track vacation and compensatory time. The Selectmen's Office will check into that.

The Board members will postpone a decision on the event permitting application until the Fire Chief and Police Chief meet and some clear guidelines are defined.

David Copeland presented a map of Strafford from the year 1871. It was suggested that the map be framed to hang in the Town Office.

There being no further business to be brought before the Board a motion was made, seconded, and voted to adjourn. The meeting adjourned at 6:54PM.
