

## Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting

October 19, 2010

Members present: Stephanie Gray, Chairman, R. Stephen Leighton and Lynn Sweet.

The meeting was called to order at 6:05 P.M.

Bills and checks for payment were reviewed.

Judy Dupre' (E-911 Liaison) attended to discuss the Old Canaan Road addressing for one house located within the town boundaries. It was noted that Barrington has recently renamed their portion of the road Old Settlers Road. Correspondence from Mike Kelleher (E-911 Field Representative) was reviewed. Board members believe that emergency services are well aware of the situation and the one house involved, and that there should be no difficulty in locating the same should the need arise. After discussion, Board was in agreement that an "Old Canaan Road" sign should be placed on the road at the town boundary line.

Herb Scribner attended to discuss the construction and paving of MacKenzie Lane. He has contracted with Precision Paving. The Board did not have any objections as long as the paving was according to specs.

Greg Messenger attended in the event there were any questions pertaining to the above road construction. There was a short discussion pursuant to plowing.

It was noted that the next construction progress meeting for the Northwood/Bow Lake Bridge Replacement project is scheduled for October 25<sup>th</sup>.

All data is backed up daily. Disks/tapes are kept onsite and off. Backing up data to a centralized location offsite (i.e. Carbonite) was discussed. Associated costs will be researched.

Clarinda Donle attended to discuss condition of fence located in the Bow Lake Grange parking lot. The Board will contact Coe-Brown to ask whether any student is still in need of a project for their Senior Portfolio. If not, the cost of repairs for the fence would be included in the proposed budget for next year, and the work would be done next Spring.

Work on the Water Street Dock Replacement Project is still tentatively scheduled to begin the first week in November. A work schedule and a list of supplies has been provided by Mr. Fink of NH Fish and Game. Delivery of supplies was discussed. Mr. Leighton will contact Michie directly to make arrangements for delivery of the blocks.
