

## Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting

1 June 2010

Members present: Stephanie Gray, Chairman, R. Stephen Leighton and Lynn Sweet.

Meeting was called to order at 6:00 P.M.

Bills and checks for payment were reviewed.

Correspondence was read.

The authorization to release payment for the new fire truck was signed.

An intent to cut timber form was reviewed and signed.

Martha Leighton attended to discuss a "Bow Lake Beautification Project". She represented a volunteer group, whose intention is to "improve the appearance of the dam area, which is the focal point of Bow Lake Village". Several suggested improvements were listed. Some of the suggested improvements included cutting overgrown vegetation (vines on fence), and fencing options (replacement/new/removal of ) along Water Street and Province Road. Timing was discussed. All were in agreement that any improvements that could be made, should be coordinated with the work scheduled to be done on the dock. Work on the dock is scheduled to be done in the fall, after the annual draw down of the lake. The Board noted that the Town leases the beach area from the State. The State will be contacted for clarification on what can be done while still maintaining compliance with the conditions of the lease agreement. Shoreland Protection Act regulations will also have to be met.

One of the projects listed was the painting of the shed at the beach. After short discussion, the Board authorized the group to go ahead with the painting project and authorized the purchase of the supplies (i.e. paint, brushes, etc.). Volunteers, possibly students, will be doing the painting.

It was noted that there is still an opening for a representative to the RDVNA. A qualified candidate was mentioned and will be contacted.

There was a general discussion considering endorsements of political candidates.

A motion was made, seconded, and voted to accept the minutes taken at the May 18, 2010 meeting of the Board.

There being no further business before the Board, a motion was made, seconded, and voted to adjourn. The meeting adjourned at 7:05 P.M.
