

Minutes of the Selectmen's Meeting June 21, 2016

Selectmen in attendance: Bryant Scott and Scott Young
In attendance: Bill Booth

The Selectmen's Meeting commenced at 5:27PM

The Board reviewed and authorized payroll and payment of bills. June 7, 2016 Selectmen's Meeting minutes were read and approved. Several items of correspondence were reviewed. Bill Booth, Building Inspector, provided some background information pertaining to a zoning/boundary dispute on Terri Court. He and the Board members discussed how best to proceed to encourage a positive outcome for all involved.

Mr. Booth expressed his concern to the Board members of an additional situation that he will continue to monitor involving a zoning violation and possible fire code violation. Mr. Booth will set up an inspection appointment and will visit the property along with the fire chief.

As a follow-up to an earlier situation on Parsons Hill Road, Mr. Booth will notify concerned parties in writing as to the progress made thus far to address their concerns.

The board members discussed the access to the well on the Hill property, for testing by the Strafford Library Association, and felt that access was possible if the rocks along Route 126 were to be moved.

The Selectmen received and reviewed correspondence from Mr. Rowe which reiterated the items of discussion at the June 7th Selectmen's Meeting. His proposal for a road agreement with the Town has been sent to the Town attorney for review.

The Selectmen's Office will compose a letter for the July 5th meeting thanking a property owner on Parker Mountain Road for his mowing of the Town land which abuts his own property.

There being no further business to be brought before the Board a motion was made, seconded, and voted to adjourn. The meeting adjourned at 6:18PM.
