

Minutes of the Selectmen's Meeting 27 May 2014

The meeting was called to order at 5:59PM.

Fire Chief Scott Whitehouse, Garland Road, reported to the Selectmen about some upcoming training for the Department. He has filed paperwork with the State for 2 controlled burning exercises. The first is the house at 961 First Crown Point Road this Saturday, May 31st and then a house on Brown's Pasture on June 28th early in the morning. As required by the State, he has notified residents in the neighborhood of the Crown Point house about the upcoming exercise. Scott would also like to make some additions to the personnel policy as it relates to the Fire Department.

There was a brief update on properties with tax liens of 2 years or more.

Bills and payroll were reviewed and payment was approved. Correspondence was reviewed. The Selectmen signed the Crown Point bridge easement deeds.

Minutes from May 13, 2014 read and approved as written.

There will be a meeting for potential bidders on the Crown Point project at the site on May 29th at 10:00.

The Selectmen reported that the Fire Chief Selection committee has met. The committee will be conducting interviews on June 3rd and 4th. Letters of notification have been sent to all applicants.

The Board discussed final preparations for opening the beach on Sunday, June 15th. They reviewed and approved a document outlining the responsibilities of the lifeguard staff that was prepared by last year's beach manager. Final staffing arrangements are being made and a swim instructor has been secured. The beach manager is looking into the purchase of T shirts for the staff.

There being no further business to be brought before the Board a motion was made, seconded, and voted to adjourn. The meeting adjourned at 7:00PM.
