

Minutes of the Selectmen's Meeting
2 October 2012

Members present: R. Stephen Leighton, Chairman, Lynn Sweet and JoAnn Brown

The meeting was called to order at 6:05PM

In attendance: Clarinda Donle, Judy Dupré

Minutes from the September 18, 2012 Selectmen's meeting were read and approved.

Correspondence was reviewed, discussed, and signed as necessary. Payment of bills and payroll was authorized.

The ongoing discussion about dock ownership continued. The Board's intention is to research ownership of boats accessing the docks.

Some clarification was made about the definition of fire roads. All fire roads come off the roads that circle the lake. A fire road cannot come off another fire road. It is possible for a fire road to be a public road or a private road.

The contract was signed with Allways Wrecking-Allways Recycling who was previously awarded the contract for the demolition of the structure at 1161 Parker Mountain Road. This property was recently purchased by the Town. The work will likely take place in November.

There was a short discussion about election preparations. Handicapped accessible areas will be clearly painted in the parking lot near the entrance.

Financial reports, revised revenues, and summary of inventory are complete and will be submitted to the State for reference in setting the Town's tax rate. Revenues are about \$4000 below the estimate.

The status of Province Road between Ricky Nelson Road and Route 202A was questioned and clarification was made as to the State's timeline and goal.

There being no further business to be brought before the Board a motion was made, seconded, and voted to adjourn. The meeting adjourned at 6:35.
