

## Minutes of the Selectmen's Meeting 6 August 2013

The meeting was called to order at 6:00PM

Payroll and bills were reviewed and payment was approved. Correspondence was reviewed and discussed as necessary. The Selectmen read a letter from Mr. David Earle expressing concern about proposed work at the State highway property. The Board also received a thank you from Ready rides for the Town's contribution to the program.

An abatement recommendation was reviewed. The Selectmen were in agreement with the assessor's recommendation for denial.

Minutes from the July 23rd Selectmen's Meeting were read and approved as written.

There was a discussion pertaining to building department staffing.

Hill Library Trustees will attend the August 20<sup>th</sup> Board Meeting to transfer the Library's deed to the Town. This was approved at the March 2013 Town Meeting.

John Orr from Kooauke Island Association will also attend the August 20<sup>th</sup> Meeting to discuss the Association's assessment.

Bob Durfee will attend the August 20<sup>th</sup> Board Meeting to discuss the Investigation and Recommendation Study prepared by Dubois and King for the replacement of the First Crown Point Bridge. Abutters to the proposed project will be invited.

Scott Barry met with the Selectmen to discuss the bond he is required to post for the reclamation of his State approved gravel operation. The Selectmen agreed on a bond amount and will reconsider their decision if necessary in several years.

Sunday, August 11, 2013 will be the last day for the life guards at the Bow Lake Beach.

After a brief discussion it was noted that continued investigation needs to be done concerning the installation of a generator at the Recycling Center.

There being no further business to be brought before the Board a motion was made, seconded, and voted to adjourn. The meeting adjourned at 7:19PM.
