

## Minutes of the Selectmen's Meeting 6 September 2011

The meeting was called to order at 5:55PM

Correspondence was reviewed and signed.

The Selectmen signed a letter addressed to the State authorizing Diane Waldron, Town Clerk, and Judith Dupre', Deputy Town Clerk, to serve as NH Boat Agents. Upon acceptance by the State, residents will be able to register their boats with the Strafford Town Clerk. Information concerning this will be forthcoming on the website and in the Town Calendar.

There was some conversation about the fact that the preliminary values were not available on [VisionAppraisal.com](http://VisionAppraisal.com) until the afternoon of August 9, when actually it had been arranged to have them online on the 8<sup>th</sup> of August. This was due to a software glitch that occurred when information was updated. Vision Appraisal rectified the error as soon as it was made known to them. Clarification concerning this error will be posted on the Town website and in the October Town Calendar.

Revaluation Hearings were held from August 29 through September 1. The assessor is revisiting a few areas around the lake and is making some further adjustments. He hopes to have the revised/final valuations ready for the Selectmen's meeting on September 20.

Greg Messenger, the Town's Road Agent is handling the repair of the guard rail at the Grange as soon he is able.

Minutes from August 23, 2011 meeting were read and approved as written.

There being no further business to be brought before the Board a motion was made, seconded, and voted to adjourn. The meeting adjourned at 6:24.
