

## Minutes of the Selectmen's Meeting February 22, 2022

Members present: Scott Young, Chairman, Brian Monahan and Lynn Sweet

The business portion of the Selectmen's Meeting was called to order at 5:30. The Selectmen reviewed and approved payroll and payment of invoices, minutes from the February 7<sup>th</sup> Work Session and the February 8<sup>th</sup> Budget Hearing were read and approved, two LUCT warrants were read, approved and signed. Miscellaneous correspondence was looked over and discussed. Applications for employment were also looked over with no decisions being made. Expenditures from one of the Town cemeteries were looked over. The Selectmen discussed the location of 128 duplicate poles. The Town is working with the Department of Energy Consumer Services Division (formerly PUC) to get the poles removed.

A boundary line discrepancy was discussed in regards to a property that is adjacent to Whig Hill. After review, it was noted the property was deeded correctly, but drawn incorrectly on the tax maps. It was noted that tax maps have no legal value but more serve as a guide. Information will be provided to the Town attorney.

Correspondence was read from a property owner regarding an ongoing project on Lake View Drive. The Selectmen noted that the provided information was from a ZBA meeting held several years ago with previous owners of the property.

The agenda for voting day (March 8<sup>th</sup>) was looked over and approved.

Barn Door Gap Bridge will be discussed at the next Selectmen's Meeting.

With no further business to address, a motion was made and seconded and voted on to adjourn. The meeting was adjourned at 6:24PM.
