

Minutes of the Selectmen's Meeting May 3, 2022

The business portion of the Selectmen's Meeting was called to order at 5:30PM. The Selectmen reviewed and approved payroll and payment of invoices, the minutes from the April 11, 2022 meeting were read and approved, a gravel tax warrant was approved and signed, current use tax warrants were reviewed, approved, and signed, as well as other miscellaneous correspondence discussed. The Selectmen also reviewed a shoreline permit. Correspondence in regard to beach operations for the upcoming summer season was read and briefly discussed. The Town is still in search of lifeguards as no applications have been received for these positions. The Selectmen reviewed and discussed the liens for outstanding property taxes with the Tax Collector.

The Selectmen reviewed a letter from a resident inquiring about Town owned land. The Selectmen will revisit this issue when the full Board is in attendance

After reviewing several applications for exemptions, Chairman Sweet made a motion to designate/authorize our Municipal Assessing Agent/Agents (currently KRT) the authority to review, approve/deny, and sign applications submitted for Tax Credits/Exemptions, as allowed by law.
