

Minutes of the Selectmen's Meeting May 31, 2022

In attendance: Dave Copeland, Dan Howard, and Joe White

The business portion of the Selectmen's Meeting was called to order at 5:30PM. The Selectmen began reviewing and approving of payroll and payment of invoices, the minutes from the May 17, 2022 meeting were read and approved. The Fire Chief was in the building and the Selectmen thanked him for putting together a great Memorial Day parade.

A letter from residents was read and discussed concerning a property that had been issued a building permit. After reading the correspondence, the Building Inspectors were asked to be in attendance to discuss the concerns brought up in the letter. Dave Copeland assured the Board that a stamped certified plot plan including delineated wetlands was provided. The Building Inspectors were asked to be vigilant in monitoring the construction and to ensure that the Town receives a certified foundation plot plan before construction can begin.

At 5:36PM, a motion was made by Lynn Sweet and seconded by Chris Garcia to recess to the conference room to participate in an interview process.

The Board reconvened at 8:30PM to complete the business portion of the meeting.

Two (2) Intents to Cut were signed, three (3) Reports of Cut were signed, a pole license was reviewed and signed, and miscellaneous correspondence was discussed.

A pay rate was discussed and approved along with a possible new employee being hired at the Recycling Center. A proposal to improve the lighting at the Recycling Center was read and approved with the work to be done as soon as possible.

It was noted that there will be a Multi Board/Department Head Meeting on June 14th.

With no further business to discuss, a motion was made, seconded, and voted on to adjourn. The meeting adjourned at 8:45PM.
