Q6 What do you think are the 3 greatest challenges facing Strafford in the next 10-15 years?







Q11 How affordable is housing in Strafford?



Q12 If additional housing development is necessary, would you prefer for it to be concentrated in specific places, or spread evenly throughout town?



Q13 Which of these options for residential development (if any) would you support? (Select all that apply)









Q18 What concerns would you have about being or raising a child in Strafford?



Q19 What concerns do you have about growing older in your community?








Q20 Express your level of support for the following. The town of Strafford should...
