

## Minutes of the Selectmen's Work Session October 11, 2022

The meeting came to order at 5:30PM. The Selectmen read and approved the minutes of the October 4, 2022 meeting. An update was given on a property confirming that the structure was boarded up from the inside and the mailbox has been removed. The Selectmen approved the time for the Town's trick-or-treating for October 30<sup>th</sup> from 5-8PM and requested that it be posted on the Town's website. Other miscellaneous correspondence was read and briefly discussed.

With Police Chief Richard stepping down, the Board has formed a selection committee to begin the process of hiring a new police chief. The Selectmen conferred with Lisa Soiett, who will be on the Selection Committee, on qualifications to be considered and procedural steps. The Selectmen decided upon November 7<sup>th</sup> as being the deadline for resumes to be submitted.

The Town Hall's server will be down 4-5 hours on Saturday, October 15<sup>th</sup> in order to install necessary upgrades.

After researching other town's policies and speaking with the Town's Attorney, the Selectmen discussed and unanimously voted against maintaining Fire Road 29.

A brief update was given on the Barn Door Gap bridge.

With no further business to discuss, a motion was made, seconded, and voted on to adjourn. The meeting adjourned at 6:29PM.
