

Minutes of the Selectmen's Work Session
November 8, 2022

Members Present: Lynn Sweet, Chairman, Brian Monahan, Chris Garcia

Meeting came to order at 1:05PM.

A brief update was given on a property where a stone wall was unintentionally pushed during snow removal several years ago. The Town has contacted a surveyor to shoot lines for verification. The cost of the surveyor was approved. The Board will further discuss this situation once the surveyor gets the report completed.

The Master Plan charrette held on Saturday was attended by 50+ people. The consensus was that good information was given to a seemingly engaged audience.

The tax rate has not been set as the State continues to wait on the SAU to get in their forms. The SAU is hoping that their remaining forms will be sent in by Friday, November 11th. With that date being a holiday, the Board acknowledged the State would not receive it until Monday, November 14th.

The Board read and approved correspondence from the Town's attorney regarding a sale of Town property.

The Selectmen also signed letters to two property owners concerning ongoing issues.

A contract for the new phones at the Town Hall was approved and signed.

The Board went point by point on a proposed Class VI Road Policies penned by the Planning Board. Several additions to the current policy were added by the Planning Board. After a lengthy discussion, the Board will revisit this at their next meeting in order to review and research.

With no other business to discuss, a motion was made, seconded, and voted on to adjourn. The meeting adjourned at 2:10PM.
