- IRCR

 - Hikers are noticing that dog walkers are not cleaning up after their animals, so signs will be placed at the kiosk instructing people to do so.
 - Bog bridge repair: no update
 - It was noted that several trees along the cow path are dying and should be removed.
- Town Forest
 - It was reported that the ash trees that are being treated are still doing well and have a heavy seed crop this year.
