

Minutes of the Selectmen's Work Session January 18, 2023

In Attendance: Scott Whitehouse, Fire Chief

The work session was called to order at 5PM.

The Board discussed and gave careful consideration for the 2023 budgets of several departments, including but not limited to Police, Fire, Highway, Building Inspection, and Recycling.

The Capital Reserve Fund balances were verified as of December 31, 2022.

At the Recycling Center, Compactor 2 has not been replaced. Since the replacement was scheduled for last week, Mr. Lachapelle of Waste Management will be contacted for an update.

With the return of a former employee at the Recycling Center, the Selectmen asked that the posting for the attendant's position on the Town's website be removed.

The Minutes from the January 10, 2022 Selectmen's Meeting was read and approved, a Veteran's Credit application was approved and signed, and miscellaneous correspondence read.

The Selectmen were notified that Ted White has offered to provide swim lessons once again at the beach this summer.

2021 BTLA abatement appeal decisions were initially looked over but will be discussed with the full Board at the regularly scheduled Selectmen's meeting Tuesday, January 24th.

An update was briefly given on a property in Town.

Before adjourning, the Selectmen discussed their upcoming meeting on Tuesday and agreed that an additional work session be scheduled for Tuesday, January 31st, providing all Selectmen can be in attendance.

With no further business to discuss, a motion was made, seconded and voted on to adjourn. Meeting adjourned at 6:38PM.
