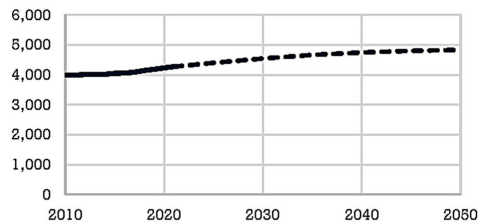

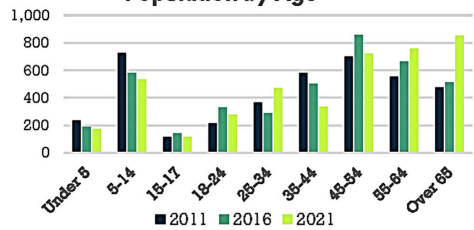

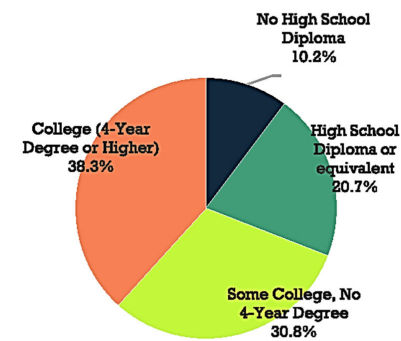
Childcare Deserts

A childcare desert is an area in which the number of children under 5 years old is at least 3 times the capacity of the daycares.

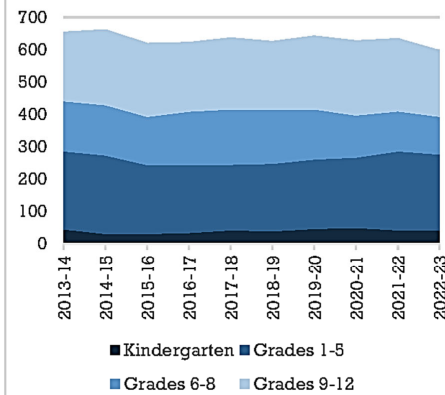
