IRCR:

No further vandalism (repeated posting of White nationalist stickers) at the IRCR kiosk in the last few weeks. Randy and others report many branches down and small trees overlaying the trails. Others also report an uptick in dog poop along Cowpath trail. May need signage as a reminder. The plowed parking lot is getting good use this winter.

Town Forest/Evans MT

- o The public is accessing the forest using plowed parking area. Use is less than at the IRCR.
- The gate is open on Evans Mt. but the snow mobile club has not had the opportunity to do maintenance.

- Site Walk review: Lake Shore Drive January 16th Around but not on Wilcox property looking at negative drainage issues caused by in fill of stream corridor. Several of these broad ephemeral stream corridors feeding the lake have been radically altered recently. They probably do not have any legal wetlands protections. We are currently at a loss as to how to proceed. They provide a service to the lake by producing cool clean water, reducing siltation and as a wildlife corridor.
