

Minutes of the Selectmen's Work Session June 20, 2023

The work session was called to order at 5:30PM.

A resident brought forth a concern on a certain property in Town and the possible expansion of use on the property. The Selectmen briefly discussed the situation, noting that this particular situation will go to the Planning and Zoning Boards.

A motion was made, seconded, and voted on to correspond with Jen Czysz at Strafford Regional Planning Board concerning an issue.

An update was given on the replacement of the Barn Door Gap Bridge. It was mentioned that an excavator had been delivered and work will begin within the next few days.

The Selectmen briefly discussed a wetlands permit filed to build a driveway on a property in Town.

The Board read and approved a draft revision from the Town's attorney concerning ruins that need to be removed on a property in Town.

A notice of pay rate for an employee was signed.

It was noted that conditional approval was received on the appointment of Joseph White as Strafford's Health Officer and Dan Howard as Deputy Health Officer, pending background and fingerprint check.

A date was set for a public hearing on July 11th at 6PM to present the possible placement of stop signs in the Whig Hill area.

Selectmen Garcia presented a plan for more of a permanent solution for the barrier situation at the Recycling Center. A welder will be contacted for a price on the fabrication.

A motion was made, seconded and voted on to adjourn. The meeting adjourned at 6:31PM.
