

## Minutes of the Selectmen's Meeting August 22, 2023

The Selectmen's Meeting was called to order at 5:30PM. The Selectmen approved payroll and the payment of the bills. The minutes from the Selectmen's meeting on August 8th were considered and approved. An employee contract, along with a notice of pay rate was signed. A use of facilities request form for voting to take place at the Strafford School was reviewed and signed. Renewal appointments for the Local River Management Advisory Committee for the State of NH were signed. Miscellaneous correspondence was read and discussed.

The Selectmen considered and approved a NH Department of Safety Grant application brought forth by the Strafford Police Department. The agreement was signed by Chairman Sweet.
