

Our Town Conservation Lands

There are marked trails on the Town Forest and the Storer Lot off Route 126 (Parker Mountain Road). A loop trail links the Town Forest and the Storer Lot, and the Storer Lot summit trail extends to Evans Mountain Road.

There is also a trail system at the Isinglass River Conservation Reserve.

Parking is available at the Town Forest on Parker Mountain Road, at the pull-off on Parker Mountain Road by the Storer Lot, and on New Road off Range Road for the Isinglass River Conservation Reserve.

Our Trails

Horseback Riders: We are sorry to say that none of our trails is designed for horses. Several are marked as not for horses, but all trails are narrow with overhanging branches, and some of our most popular trails have narrow bog bridges.

Hunting and Fishing: Hunting and fishing are permitted on all our properties. Hunters, please be mindful of the locations of our popular hiking trails.

Dog Owners: Please pick up after your dogs out of respect for other humans, other dogs, and wildlife.

And please, no wheeled vehicles. They can damage the trails and the plants alongside.
