 - Idea- interactive map, with overlays that would be accessible via the town website
- Join the Club idea to incorporate Strafford residents that are currently involved in agriculture activities, wish to be, and/or interested in supporting local agriculture, bringing community awareness to the natural resources and land use that make up Strafford
 - Initial info-gathering meeting date set for April 13th @ 4PM, Waldron's Store
 - Who? Invite existing Strafford residents, with focus on Farming/Ag activities
 - How? Post the meeting via the Strafford Community Calendar (deadline 3/15 for entries). Signs in locations at Library, post office, Isinglass Store, Strafford Facebook page?
 - What? Survey, open discussion regarding idea and who would be interested in participating, if it became a recurring event(s) in/around town
 - o Farm days? Street Signs? Club benefits? Networking? Services?
