The meeting was called to order by Scott Young at 7:04 pm. Debbie made a motion to accept the June 3rd minutes as amended and Randy seconded. The motion to accept passed.

GUEST PRESENTATION: Coveland Farm update presented by Bear Paw director Krystal Balanoff. Due to a lack of support from LCHIP, the costs associated with placing a conservation easement on the property have not been met and an extension of one year was agreed upon to find alternate funding. Initially the Conservation Commission pledged \$ 50,000.00 to the project. The funding shortfall is about \$ 60,000.00 and the end date is October 2024.

The commission reviewed all the benefits of conserving the property, the threat posed to Bow Lake of increasing incidences of cyanobacterial blooms and the importance of this property in mitigating disruption of Bow Lakes third biggest watershed.

An increase in funding of the project by an additional \$35,0000.00 was proposed. The commission voted unanimously to support this proposal. Our total support has increased to \$85,0000.00.

Trademark subdivision proposal presented regarding perennial stream crossing of Foss Brook on property adjacent to Coveland Farm/ Water Street. Presentation to Planning board on September 6th.
