

Minutes of the Selectmen's Meeting April 1, 2025

Members Present: Lynn Sweet, Chair; Brian Monahan; Steve Leighton
In Attendance: Police Chief Randy Young; Tim and Carole Oljey

The meeting was called to order at 5:30PM. Payroll and payments of invoices were reviewed and approved. The minutes of the March 18th Selectmen's meeting were read and approved. Notices of pay rate/contracts for Town employees were reviewed and signed. A current use tax warrant was signed. Miscellaneous correspondence was read.

Police Chief Randy Young met with the Board.

At this time a motion was made by Steve Leighton and seconded by Brian Monahan to enter into a non-public session pursuant to RSA 91-A:3 II (a). Roll call was taken as follows:

The Board entered non-public session at 5:45PM.

A motion was made by Brian Monahan to leave non-public session and seconded by Steve Leighton to return to public session. Roll call was taken as follows:

Public session reconvened at 5:55PM.

No votes were taken or decisions were made during the non-public session.

A motion was made by Lynn Sweet and seconded by Brian Monahan to seal the minutes of the non-public session. Roll call was taken as follows:

Correspondence from the State's Department of Transportation regarding their paving schedule was read and discussed, noting the roads that are on the docket to be paved or top coated.

Correspondence from Dubois & King was read in response to information requested from the State Department of Transportation. In summary, Dubois & King has been in contact with the State and will be sending a report to them.

Ongoing old business was reviewed with no known updates. An agreement between the Selectmen and an owner of property with a large tax lien was read and signed.

After reviewing a pole license and having a brief discussion, it was determined the pole would be on a Fire Road and the Town has no jurisdiction to sign the agreement. The owner of the property would be responsible for its signing.

The report of appropriations (MS-232) was read and approved for the State.

Two abatement recommendations prepared by the Town's Assessor were read and reviewed. Further explanation will be needed from the Assessor before the Selectmen agree with the findings.

The Selectmen discussed a personnel policy and were in agreement not to waver from the previous practice of having all new Town employees meeting with the Town Administrator to ensure all the necessary paperwork has been submitted properly prior to their start date.

With no further business to discuss, a motion was made, seconded and voted on to adjourn. The meeting adjourned at 7:01PM.
