Old Business

Ev Charger Update:

- Jay reached out to owners of the Bow Lake Inn, they were not interested in the EV station
- Hammond reached out to 7Cs, they are considering hearing a presentation
- The grant from VW may cover infrastructure to bring level 3 to Isinglass Store. The owner was the most positive about installing a charging station.

Meeting with Superintendent Rob Seaward

- Sidewalk Update- presented 2 possibilities as designed by Lynda Cecchetti - supported the right of way to get students to the library safely via the school to library pathway. Could be a community project dependent on permits. School maintenance would be responsible for maintaining the path.
 - Next step: Report to the Board of Selectmen the outcome of the meeting
- Hammond Brown met with the Superintendent to present energy efficiency programs for the school.
 - Meeting with the facilities committee to have dialogue in regard to energy efficiency and renewables.
 - Presentation to be scheduled for facilities Committee
 - Ideas include: energy audit, LED lighting updates etc., alternative energy, curriculum programming etc.
 - Next steps: Hammond will reach out to Board members to arrange a presentation.
